All of them were scanned the same way except for the one of Sleeping Bear. That was scanned from a negative, at very high resolution, and that is why the file is so big. But there is a problem with the CD. I am sending replacements to all of you.

The way to use these CDs is to double-click on the file named index.html. That starts up Internet Explorer and brings up a page with thumbnails of all the pictures. The thumbnails are linked to the actual image files, so when you click on a thumbnail, Internet Explorer brings up the picture itself. Then you can zoom in far enough to see people's nose hairs. It works fine on my PC.

My friend Alan scanned the Sleeping Bear photo at the highest resolution available on his scanner (4000 x 4000) and then he spent several hours using Adobe Photoshop to clean off the dust and dirt. Now I want to see how large a print I can get without losing sharpness.
